Where should I park?

We have two car parks, one at Watts Gallery and another at Limnerslease. Follow the parking signs on your arrival. There is a short walk of approximately five minutes between the two sides of our site. A £1 parking charge applies.

Please redeem your ticket at the Visitor Centre (Watts Gallery side) or at The Canvas Room café (Limnerslease side)

What does my ticket include?

Your ticket includes access to all our February half term activities as well as access to our Historic Gallery, De Morgan Gallery, Sculpture Gallery, Women of Influence: Pattle Sisters exhibition and our grounds and gardens including the Verey Playwood.

Watts Chapel is located at the top of a steep hill and accessed by a cobbled path, which can be a barrier for buggies. There is currently no lift access to Watts Contemporary Gallery.

Changing & feeding

Accessible toilets are located at Watts Gallery, the Watts Cafe and Limnerslease. Baby change facilities are located in the toilet block outside the Café and at Limnerslease.
